Abstract. The family Jacobsoniidae and species *Sarothrias crowsoni* Löbl & Burckhardt, 1988 from the Philippines, Mindanao Island is newly recorded.

collection of Albert Allen (Idaho, U.S.A.). Species known from Malaysia: Sabah (Háva 2016, Cai et al. 2017, Yin & Bi 2018), distribution extended to Mindanao Island and first recorded family Jacobsoniidae from the Philippines.
