Anthrenus (Anthrenus) quernerii Holloway, 2024 (Coleoptera: Dermestidae) from Czech Republic and Slovakia

Abstract. The species *Anthrenus (Anthrenus) quernerii* Holloway, 2024 is recorded for the first time from the Czech Republic and Slovakia. The species is very similar to the common species *Anthrenus (Anthrenus) pimpinellae* (Fabricius, 1775) but differs from it by the colour of the elytral patterns and the structure of the male genitalia.

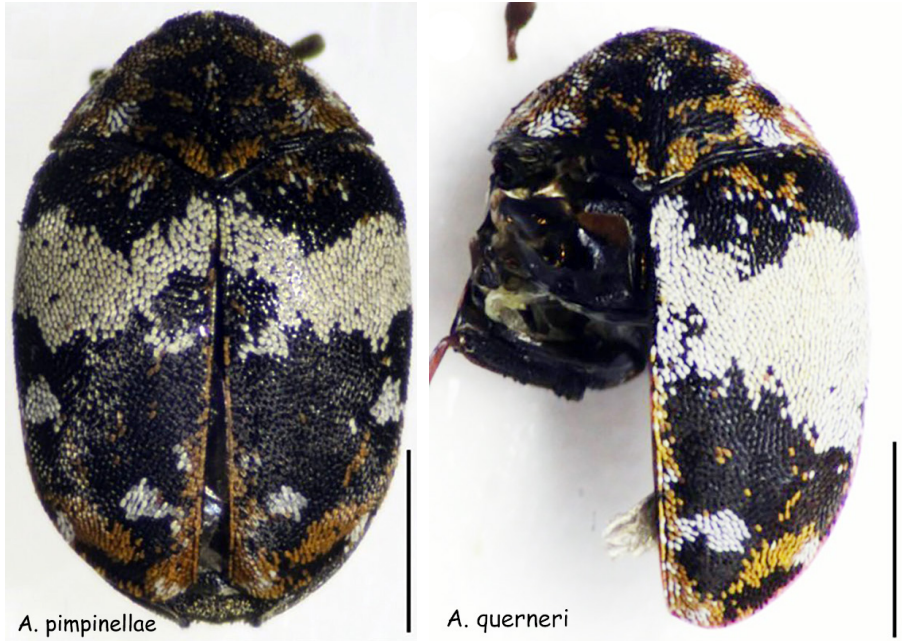


Fig. 2. Habitus, according to Holloway (2024).
